STIPULATED FINAL JUDGMENT

In accordance with the separate Order entered on this date, approving the parties' settlement under the Fair Labor Standards Act, it is **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** that **JUDGMENT** be, and the same hereby is, entered in favor of plaintiff, Andrea Thomas, and opt-in plaintiffs, Cherry Marler, Frangelica Turner and Corina Woodward, and against defendants, Port II Seafood & Oyster Bar, Inc., d/b/a Mikee's Seafood, and Edwin Spence, Jr., jointly and severally, in the total amount of **\$31,027.94**. It is further **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** that this sum is to be allocated as follows:

1. to plaintiff Andrea Thomas, \$2,022.72 in back pay and an equal sum in liquidated damages, for a total of **\$4,045.44**;
2. to opt-in plaintiff Cherry Marler, \$1,546.03 in back pay and an equal sum in liquidated damages, for a total of **\$3,092.06**;
3. to opt-in plaintiff Frangelica Turner, \$1,360.71 in back pay and an equal sum in liquidated damages, for a total of **\$2,721.42**;
4. to opt-in plaintiff Corina Woodwards, \$1,584.51 in back pay and an equal sum in liquidated damages, for a total of **\$3,169.02**; and
5. the sum of **\$18,000.00** in attorney's fees.
